

Organisation environmental policy



The scope of business of company Amphenol Tuchel Industrial GmbH, branch Ostrov (hereinafter referred to as ATI Ostrov) is the production of cable sets and electronic reader for various applications in transport, industry, services and healthcare. The ATI Ostrov is located in a rented building, which is situated in the former Tesla Ostrov area. The environmental impact is mainly due to the generation of wastes in the processing of cables and customer connectors, the consumption of electricity, gas and drinking water and in a small extent of emissions of volatile hydrocarbons and solid particles.
